DO'S & DON'T FOR GRINDER PUMP SEWER SYSTEMS

DO

- 1. Use liquid detergents
- 2. Use DAWN dish detergent
- 3. Call (074-882-2319) if you see a red light or hear a buzzer at the lift station
- 4. Limit water if your system is in an alarm situation.

DON'T

- 1. Do not use powered detergents
- 2. Do not place cooking greases and/or fats in the garbage disposal
- 3. Do not flush feminine products and/or condoms down the toilet.
- 4. Do not pour carpet cleaning water down the drain
- 5. Do not allow dental floss into your system
- 6. Do not plant shrubs or bushes within 3 feet of the tank.
- 7. Do not place heavy objects such as bird baths or planters on top of the tank lid.
- 8. Do not flush anything that in not water-soluble (example; rags, brown hand towels, toys, cigarette packs, etc...)

NOTE: During a power outage, you will have water, however, your sewer system will not operate. Continuing to use water, you system will fill to the top and possibly run over. When power is restored your system will go into alarm, however, given time, it will pump the water down and the alarm will silence. If the alarm is still present after 1 hour, please call the office.
